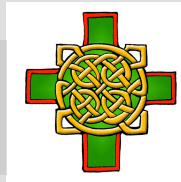

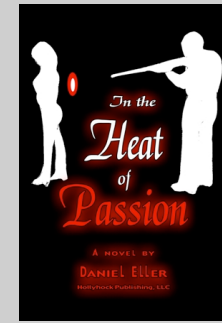
Irish Music & Dancing at the Celtic Junction
